ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Hanalia P.C. College, Handia, Allahabad-221503, (U.P.)** for B.Ed. of One year from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 70 (Seventy) students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
2. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
3. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University/State Government.
4. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
5. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University/Examining body.
6. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
7. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 7 above.

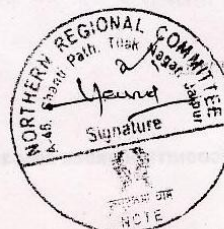
ORDER

Handia Post Graduate College, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition for BTC of Two Year duration in terms of section 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Handia Post Graduate College, Handia, Allahabad-221503, Uttar Pradesh for an annual intake of 50 seats (Fifty Only) (50 seats in the 1st year and the same for the IInd year in BTC course of two year duration with effect from 6th October, 2004 subject to compliance of the following conditions before the commencement of the academic session.

- (a) Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/ State Govt./SCERT is to be completed before the commencement of the session.
- (b) The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Director, SCERT should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session.
- (c) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- (d) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (e) That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers & Staff be created within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/institution, for a period of not less than sixty months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- (f) Before starting the course the institution should seek prior permission of the competent authority for conducting the exams and approved of the curriculum that they are going to adopt for the course.
- (g) Institutions if starts the training programme without prior approval/permission of competent authority/examining body regarding the curriculum they have adopted and conduct of examination for award of Diploma/Certificate the recognition of such institutions shall be withdrawn.
- (h) Non-compliance of the above mentioned conditions shall cause action under section 17 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

3. The Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating body shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department), as per the norms of the NCTE / State Govt. / Affiliating body.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like SCERT/ State Government, etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above-mentioned land.
- (c) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5,00,000 (Rupees Five lacs Only) and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupee three lacs Only).
- (d) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal, Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Handia Post Graduate College, Handia, Allahabad- 211503 (U.P.) for an intake of 50 seats (Fifty) seats in B.P.Ed. course of one year duration with effect from the academic session 2003-2004 subject to fulfillment of the following before the commencement of the session.

- (a) Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/State Govt./UGC is to be completed before the commencement of the session.
 - (b) The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Registrar of the concerned University should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session 2003-2004.
 - (c) The institution shall adhere to all the other Regulations and Guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
 - (d) The institution shall within ONE MONTH of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a joint account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than **SIXTY MONTHS (Five years)** in a Nationalized Bank only (and not any other certificate) to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - (e) That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers & staff be maintained, in the form of FDR in favour of the management / institution, for a period of not less than **SIXTY MONTHS (Five years)** in a Nationalized Bank.
 - (f) **Non-compliance of above conditions as mentioned vide this Order of Recognition shall invite action under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.**
4. The Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating University shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed requisite number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE / UGC / Affiliating University.
 5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
 6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND, WHEREAS, the recognition has been granted to the institutions mentioned in para 5 below for the course mentioned against their name.

3. AND, WHEREAS, the said institutions by affidavit have consented to come under New Regulations and have sought for the number of units in B.Ed./B.P.Ed./M.Ed. as mentioned in para 5 below against their name, which may require additional facilities.

4. AND, WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have the desired number of units subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- The applicant Institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents, such as, land documents, Non Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) and Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website of the Regional Committee in proof of having provided the additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of the premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution has failed to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. This order shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case and in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc. as decided by the Northern Regional Committee.

5. Now, therefore, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to the following institutions for conducting the under-mentioned programme/intake of two years duration from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions before 31.10.2015 mentioned in para 4 above:-

7. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.


8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following mandatory disclosure:-

- Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
- Names of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- Names of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- Fee charged from students.
- Available infrastructural facilities.
- Facilities added during the last quarter.
- Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- The affidavit with enclosures submitted along with application.
- The institution shall be free to post and additional information, if it so desires.

10. Any false or incomplete information on the website of the institution shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there-under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
